

Restricted/Unacceptable Materials

We kindly ask before using Dirt Dump that you please sort out garbage, wood/trees/branches and concrete materials as best you can. Our team must go through these loads after being dumped and clean out materials that we cannot bring to our additional dump site. Once removed, these materials must be disposed of accordingly and we end up paying city dump fees to do so. Below is a general list of the materials we will not accept. If these materials are found in significant volumes in a load, a **clean-up fee of \$100** will be applied, or the vehicle may be turned away. Pictures of garbage found in loads have also been provided for a visual reference of unacceptable materials.

WE DO NOT ACCEPT:

- **Garbage** – plastic materials, recyclables, wires, tubing, paper/cardboard etc.
- **Wood** – plywood, 2x4s, MDF, stakes, etc.
- **Trees/Branches** – bushes, shrubs, logs, root balls, full trees, branches/large sticks etc.
- **Concrete** – concrete blocks/paving stones, broken concrete etc.
- Any load Contaminated with other materials like **oil, fuel, tar** etc.

* **Rocks** larger than a fist size in any load besides a clay load & **Large Roots** *will be accepted* but must be separated out of the load!
